NQT Teaching and Learning Workshops - A series of 8 half day workshops run at the teaching school.

Monday 31st October – 1.30pm-4.00pm – Effective teaching and learning (Introductory session)

- Introduction to the programme, each other and sharing induction planners
- What are the component parts of effective teaching and learning?
- Opportunity to observe and give feedback on a lesson

Wednesday 30th November – 1.30pm-4.00pm – Differentiation

- How do you meet the needs of all learners?
- How can we achieve 'flow' within lessons?
- What are the challenges of getting differentiation right?

Wednesday 25th January – 1.30pm-4.00pm – Display to support teaching and learning

- Approaches to whole class questioning

Monday 24th April – 1.30pm-4.00pm – Effective use of support staff

- How can we ensure effective relationships and communication with support staff?
- How can we ensure that support staff have impact?
- What does the most up to date research state about effective use of support staff?

Monday 25th May – 1.30pm-4.00pm – Making learning memorable

- How do we engage pupils within the lesson?
- How do we ensure all pupils contribute?
- How can we enhance the school curriculum and what resources are available to support this?

Monday 19th June – 1.30pm -4.00pm – Working with parents/Maintaining a reflective approach

- How to promote effective relationships with parents
- Resources to support ongoing professional development into a career in teaching

Workshops will be facilitated by experienced teachers and senior leaders and include a range of learning experiences (observation, learning walks, hands on activities, discussion, presentations and signposting to relevant materials, reading and resources).

NQTs will also receive a Hales Valley Induction Planner which can be used to support their induction year.
