



### Workshop to Raise Awareness of Prevent (WRAP)

The statutory guidance refers to the importance of Prevent awareness training to equip staff to identify children at risk of being drawn into terrorism and to challenge extremist ideas.

As a minimum, schools should ensure that the Designated Safeguarding Lead undertakes Prevent awareness training and is able to provide advice and support to other members of staff on protecting children from the risk of radicalisation.

(The Prevent Duty, 2015, DfE)

At Hales Valley Teaching School we have a number of Home Office accredited facilitators who are trained to deliver the Workshop to Raise Awareness of Prevent (WRAP). This is the core training product developed by the Home Office enabling schools to meet the statutory guidance.

There are a number of different packages available:

**Prevent in Primary Schools Package including WRAP** – Relevant for SLT members, designated safeguarding leads and SMSC leaders who want to embed the messages from Prevent throughout their whole school

Cost - £150 per delegate

**WRAP session for governors or senior leaders** – Awareness training delivered to senior leaders or governors either in your setting or at the teaching school

Cost - £300 per session

**WRAP session for staff meetings** - Awareness training delivered to staff in your setting (maximum 45 members of staff per session)
